About the Cahaba River Ramble

The Cahaba River Ramble Trail Race, held each spring, is a spectacular 5k and 10-mile trail race along the "biological heart" of Alabama's longest remaining free-flowing river, the Cahaba, and is the primary annual fundraiser for our CLEAN Environmental Education Program. Located in the Cahaba River National Wildlife Refuge while the treasured Cahaba Lilies are in full bloom, the race is certainly one of the most unique running experiences in Alabama. Last year, we served more than 200 people from 6 states, exposing them to the beauty and importance of the river.

In conjunction with the Ramble is our "C the River" Conservation and Education Event – a free & family-friendly series of "Education Rambles" led by some of our region's premiere nature and wildlife experts including reptiles, a nature walk, and environmental education activities.

About the Cahaba River Society

Founded in 1988, the Cahaba River Society (CRS) is one of Alabama's largest watershed conservation organizations and is recognized nationally for environmental stewardship. Our mission is to restore and protect the Cahaba River watershed and its rich diversity of life. This diversity includes not only the river's diverse freshwater life, but also the diverse people of the central Alabama region who rely on the Cahaba for clean, low-cost drinking water. The Cahaba River is the primary drinking water source for about one million people in the Cahaba watershed and drinking water service area. Education is the top priority of our strategic plan and we seek to influence characteristics associated with environmentally responsible behavior. The partners associated with our program include public and private schools, local and state government agencies, corporations, and other conservation groups. We are working together to build partnerships for cost-effective program planning and resource sharing.

About the Shane Hulsey CLEAN Environmental Education Program

Our goal for the CLEAN program (Children Linking Environmentally Across the Nation) is to build environmental literacy and promote sound environmental decision-making among future leaders by providing quality, hands-on environmental education to students and teachers in the Cahaba River Watershed. Since its inception in 1996, the CLEAN Program has provided hands-on educational field trips, teacher workshops, and interdisciplinary classroom curriculum activities to more than 19,500 students and teachers in the Cahaba River watershed and drinking water service area. To accomplish this goal, our staff conducts field trips, offers teacher workshops, participates in outreach activities and leads volunteer restoration projects throughout the Cahaba watershed.
